Pupil Destination Data – Academic Year 2023-2024

The academic year 2023-2024 saw 6 pupils leave The Tower School.

You will find below destination data for the 33% (2/6) of pupils who left The Tower School in July 2024 as natural, end of Key stage leavers. These pupils were supported into further education and are studying a Level 1 course at New City College and a Level 2 course at Barking & Dagenham College.

The remaining four pupils left throughout the academic year were not end of Key Stage leavers and were supported into alternative provisions.
