Pupil Destination Data – Academic Year 2024-2025

The academic year 2024-2025 saw 14 pupils leave The Tower School.

You will find below destination data for the 71% (10/14) of pupils who left The Tower School in July 2025 as natural, end of Key stage leavers. These pupils were supported into their next steps which have included college and alternative education.

The remaining four pupils left throughout the academic year were not end of Key Stage leavers and were supported into alternative provisions.
